Volunteer Frequently Asked Questions

Why volunteer at the 2011 Cox Celebrity Championship hosted by Drew Brees?

Each year, the Cox Celebrity Championship volunteers are an essential part of ensuring a smooth and effective golf tournament. The Cox Celebrity Championship offers a wide variety of opportunities for all volunteers. It's a unique and rewarding experience at a very exciting event!

What do I receive for volunteering?

Each volunteer will receive:

- An official tournament golf shirt, four (4) tournament tickets and a parking pass.
- Breakfast and/or lunch at the event as well as an invitation to the Volunteer Appreciation Party immediately following the check presentation on Sunday, May 22nd.
- Also, after 12 hours minimum of volunteer work, volunteers will receive a round of golf (cart fees will apply) at Morgan Run Resort and Club. Limit one per person.

When do I have to register by?

If you are able to volunteer in this year's Cox Celebrity Championship, you must register and pay in full by **April 1, 2011**. How much is the volunteer fee?

The registration fee is \$35 to help offset the cost of the volunteer shirts. You will have the option to pay your fee online by logging onto www.celebritychampionship.com, or you may send a check. When do I pay my volunteer fees?

To ensure that we can order your proper shirt size, all fees need to be paid in full by **April 1, 2011**.

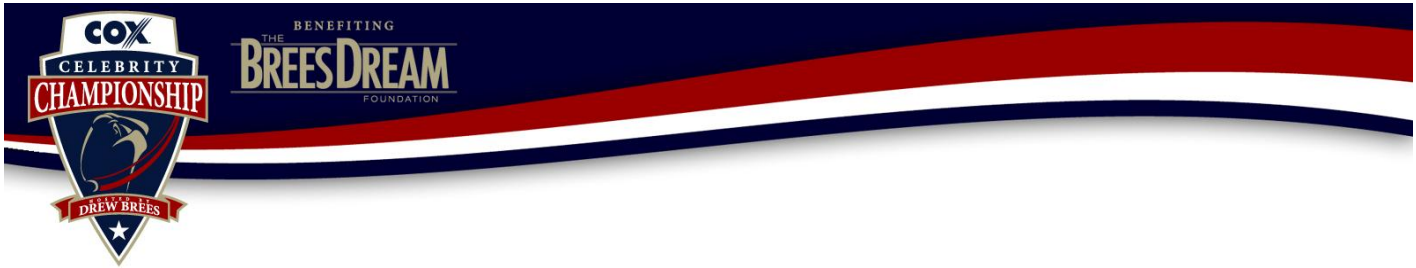
What are the requirements I need to fulfill as a volunteer?

You will need to fill out a volunteer registration form and pay your \$35 fee by April 1, 2011. Volunteers are asked to work at least two (2) shifts during the Cox Celebrity Championship, each lasting approximately four hours. Additionally, golf experience is required for all of the scoring and player service committees. The majority of volunteer committees are in operation from Friday, May 20 to Sunday, May 22.

If I have never played golf before, can I still volunteer?

Yes, absolutely!! Some of the committees require no previous experience in playing or even watching golf. However, golf experience is required for all of scoring and player services. The scoring and player service jobs include leader board, scorers, standard bearers, marshals, caddies and practice

range services. There is something for everyone and we encourage people of all levels of experience to volunteer and learn more about golf.

When do I find out what my schedule and assigned committee will be?

On your Volunteer Response Form, you are asked to rate your committee preferences by numbering them 1, 2, & 3. Please note that volunteer assignments will be made on a first come, first serve basis. During the volunteer training session in the middle of May, you will meet with your committee chairs and receive your schedule of the events and times. In some cases you will hear from your committee chair prior to volunteer training night.

When do I receive my official volunteer shirt?

On your Volunteer Application, you will be asked to provide your preferred shirt size. Those who have registered and paid in full by **April 1, 2011** will be guaranteed their shirt size. A volunteer orientation session will be held in the middle of May. The session will consist of the distribution of volunteer shirts, name badges and other amenities.

Can I come to watch the Cox Celebrity Championship on a day I am not assigned to volunteer?

Yes, you are provided with four (4) tournament tickets in your volunteer pack, which are good for any day. You may use these tickets to attend the tournament when you are not working. Please note you must have a ticket to enter the gates as a spectator.

Can I be assigned to volunteer with a friend or family member who is also volunteering?

There will be an opportunity for volunteers to indicate their preferences to volunteer during the same days as their friends or family members when schedule availability information is obtained. Whenever possible, such special requests will be accommodated. Please make sure to indicate any special requests on the Volunteer Application before sending it in.

When will I have my volunteer training session?

A volunteer orientation session will be held in the mid-May. The session will consist of the distribution of volunteer shirts, name badges and other amenities, committee training sessions and other pertinent information. All volunteers will be encouraged to attend.

When will I receive my credential for volunteering?

During the volunteer training session in mid-May.
